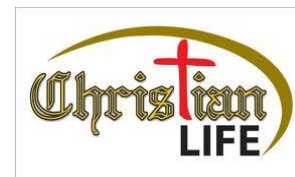
* After review of movie, "Interview with God", we decided not to show it at church. We were disappointed with the story. However, the DVD is available for anyone to borrow and watch.
